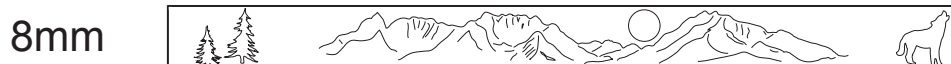
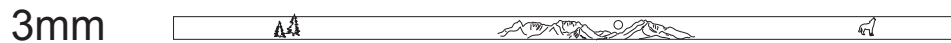
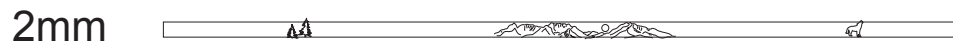


## RING BAND WIDTH EXPLANATION

Set this pdf to 100%, and if you print it, make sure the "Shrink oversized pages to paper size" and "Expand small pages to paper size" boxes are unchecked in the print dialog box. You can verify that the size is correct by comparing the ruler on this page to a physical ruler.

All of our rings may have custom band widths to suit your preferences. This guide will give you examples and measurements. Do bear in mind though, that as you decrease the width of band sizes, 2 things will occur: 1) your mountain scenes and other designs will become so tiny that they will be unrecognizable, and; 2) the durability of sterling silver rings at widths of 3 or 4 mm is questionable (while 14 or 18kt golds are fine).

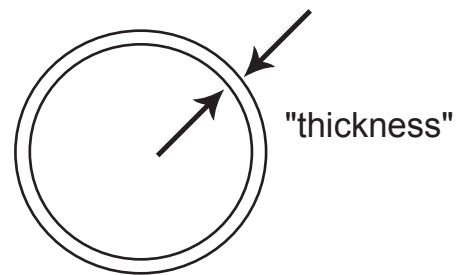
Here are actual widths in millimeters with the same graphics in a variety of sizes.



## Straight Band

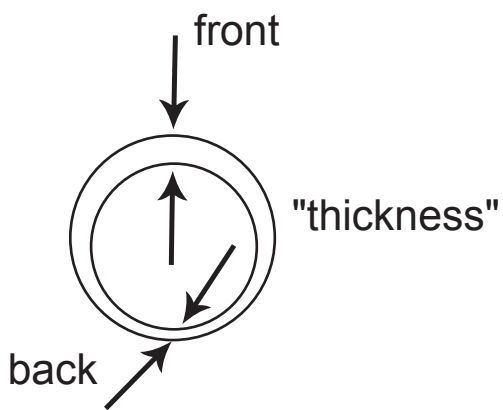


Tall Peaks Ring



This band is 8mm wide and the thickness of the ring is 1.8mm. It is not only comfortable, but very durable.

## Tapered Band



This size 9 ring tapers in width from 9mm at the front to 3.5mm at the back.

The thickness in the front of the ring is 3.5mm and 2mm at the back.
